If you do not remember your finger size or if you do not have a ring sizer to measure it, you can measure the circumference of the finger on which you wish to wear the jewel or, alternatively, determine the right size using another ring as reference.

In any case, we recommend circumference measurement as the easiest and safest way to find the most appropriate size.

CIRCUMFERENCE MEASUREMENT

Take a flexible tape meter and wrap it around the finger on which you wish to wear your Cammilli ring. We advise also to measure your knuckle: in this way you will be able to identify the size allowing you to put the ring on and take it off more easily.

Alternatively you can wrap a cord or ribbon around the base of your finger, always taking into account the size of your knuckle. With a pen, mark the point where the cord ends and measure the same cord with a ruler.

In the end you will be able to identify the size that is closest to the one shown in the table here on the left. To establish the correct size of the ring, remember to convert the size of the circumference in mm to the corresponding Italian size.

TIPS

- To achieve the most accurate result possible, we recommend you measuring the size of your finger multiple times during the day and also in different days, given the fact that the size of your finger can vary during the day and also according to the weather conditions.
- 2. Moreover is better to avoid to measure the finger when you have cold or wet hands: the size may result smaller than its real size.

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SIZE CHART

Take as a reference a ring that fits well on the finger on which you wish to wear your new Cammilli ring. Print the conversion chart page making sure the "Scale to fit" option is unchecked in the print dialogue box. To check that the Ring Size Chart has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 1 cm.



- 1. Now place your ring over the circles below to determine which one matches your size. The inside of the ring should exactly match with the inner circle.
- 2. Note that the length in mm of the finger circumference provides the French size. So, do not forget to find the corresponding Italian size in the conversion table in the previous page.
- 3. In case you are undecided between two sizes, we suggest you to choose the larger one.
- 4. Depending on the type of ring, it might not be possible to produce certain sizes.
